At the 12 monthly judgings, we had 115 plant entries, our judges nominated 61 plants and gave out 19 awards. At the 4 shows and 1 Outreach Judging that we were at, we had 1061 plant entries, 59 plants were nominated and we gave out 16 awards.

We are very excited for 2024 when more societies are planning their shows already and we will continue rotating our monthly judgings between the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island. Thank you to all the exhibitors and societies for your continued support at our monthly meetings and we look forward to seeing you at AOS Judging events in 2024!
